#### TRIPP'S TIPS

Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia) is a common turfgrass disease found on St. Augustine and Zysia Grass lawns. We see it every year with damp/humid and cooler conditions (Usually fall and spring here in Central TX).

If you see irregular circle patterns turning yellow quickly this fall, there is a good chance you are experiencing Brown Patch. The good thing is that Brown Patch is not typically too damaging to your grass, but it will be aesthetically less attractive.



Changing cultural practices by not over-fertilizing with nitrogen and only watering in the morning just as the sun is coming up to allow the grass to dry quickly are a couple of good ways to reduce an outbreak of Brown Patch. A fungicide treatment can also help manage the continued spread, however, don't expect the grass to recover very quickly. Cooler weather causes the regrowth to be slow.
