What is Wastewater Averaging?

Wastewater averaging is how the MUD determines how much you will be charged for wastewater for the next year.

Since the MUD does not have meters on the wastewater lines leaving your property, utility billing averages water use for November to February to determine what you will be billed. Your water use is the lowest at this time of year, as very little or no water is required for outdoor use.

Your updated wastewater charge will be reflected on your April 2024 bill.

Santa will arrive by Fire truck at 2:00 pm, and toy donations will be accepted for Brown Santa.



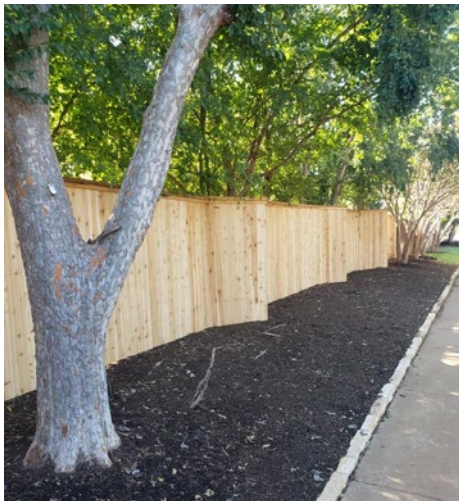
